

(RMC 4-4-100.J.4):

4. Political Signs:

a. Permitted Location: In addition to being permitted on the public right-of-way, political signs may be displayed on private property with the consent of the property owner or the lawful occupant thereof and on public right-of-way as long as such display does not interfere with pedestrian or public safety.

b. Maximum Size: Political signs shall not be greater than thirty two (32) square feet if single faced or sixty four (64) square feet if multi-faced.

c. Removal Required: Each political sign shall be removed within fourteen (14) days following an election, by the candidate, candidate's representative or proposition sponsor except that the successful candidates of a primary election may keep their signs on display until fourteen (14) days after the general election, at which time they shall be promptly removed. After fourteen (14) days the City may pick up and dispose of remaining signs. Violation or failure to comply with the provisions of this section shall subject the offender to RMC 1-3-2, Code Enforcement and Penalties. (Ord. 3719, 4-11-1983; Amd.
